Project description

TXINBADIA+ is a project building upon the network linking the facilities of the Marismas de Txingudi (wetlands) Marshes and the Basque Corniche. Its objective is to address reconditioning of these natural areas by reconciling public use (daily, leisure, tourism) with natural conservation. To achieve this, the project delivers specific **training** for people employed in the network's facilities and designs **reconditioning actions** for wetlands with an objective to improve public use and conservation tools.

By generating new cooperative dynamics and increasing engagement of local population and visitors, the project demonstrates the possibility to combine environmental conservation with intensive public use (400.000 visitors / year in two small spaces). It also demonstrate how the challenges faced by densely populated, cross-border areas can be the source of innovative governance tools.

Outcomes of the project

- The creation of a **cross-border working environment** involving technicians and politicians.
- The development of **communication tools**.
- The **support for technical personnel** of the spaces: exchanges, training, cross-border resource center, etc.
- A Pan-European cooperation network for similar areas.
